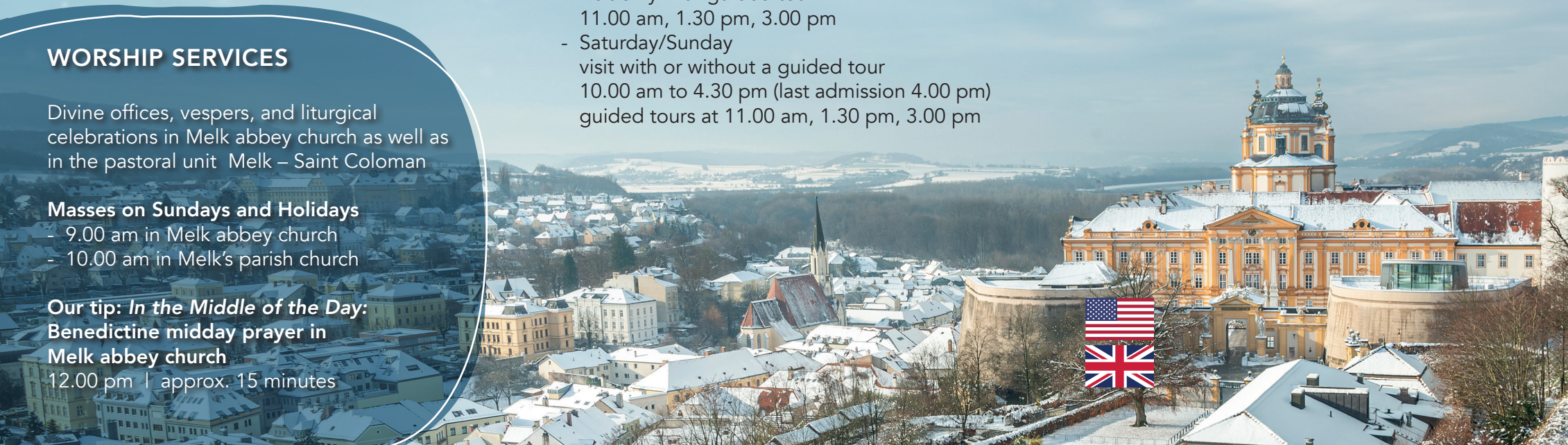

- ② **Imperial Staircase** – the former entrance for imperial guests, entrance to the exhibition
- ③ **Abbey museum** the former Imperial Rooms
- ④ **Marble Hall**
- ⑤ **Balcony** – offers a view of the Danube valley and the town of Melk
- ⑥ **Library** a treasure trove for historic books
- ⑦ **Abbey Church** a jewel of High Baroque architecture
- ⑧ **Columned Hall** – special exhibition (until January 10, 2026)
- ⑨ **Northern Bastion** – special exhibition (until January 10, 2026)
